

## Ministry Clarity - Creative Ideas

Of all the ministries at Christ The King, the highest priority to me is the school.

Thru the school we are saving more kids in our home town from the ever-growing degradation of contemporary culture.

I believe our 5-Year Plan should include a new wing addition for the school as envisioned in the work of the Facilities Task Force.

Triggers to launch the new wing addition may include:

- When all available church rooms (7 rooms) have been converted to classrooms. (Done).
- When church congregation wants all or some of the 7 rooms back for various ministries and meetings. (Happening).
- When school enrollment is growing and current classrooms are filling to capacity (16 students in each room). (Happening).
- When there is a waiting list of new students and new students are being turned away. (Happening).
- When the public is demonstrating a demand for School Choice and the MO Legislature is moving in that direction. (Happening).
- When church endowment funds are growing. (Happening).
- When monthly offerings are strong and sustaining monthly operating costs. (Questionable right now?)
- When the economy is strong and mortgage interest rates are more favorable. (Questionable right now?)
- When key donors are motivated and ready to go. (Likely, but this info is confidential).
- When 600 congregants, church council, and pastors are ready to go. (Prayerfully).

When all or some of these triggers are met, I favor constructing a new wing addition.

If we don't teach our children to follow Christ, the world will teach them not to.
